

Comms to Members re Refurbishment Submissions

Kia ora members,

It was pleasing to receive several submissions from members in relation to the proposed refurbishment plans that were on display in the clubrooms recently. The Club will be responding to individual submitters, acknowledging the respective issues that they raised in their submissions.

The overwhelming feeling the refurbishment steering committee got from the submissions was that whilst this work was overdue, members were nervous and now was possibly not the right economic environment to proceed with such a major project. The committee would like to acknowledge this feeling and assure members that the project was always intended to be a staged process and that each stage would progress only when it was affordable to do so.

One of the other common themes to come through the submissions was the removal of the Norfolk Pine and reroofing of the main club structure were priority goals that needed to be achieved before any interior refurbishment work could proceed. The steering committee has recommended to the Board that these projects be undertaken as soon as it is economically feasible to do so.

The Board will now consider these recommendations and report back to the members on their decision.
